## Colorado Springs Philharmonic receives \$70,000 in grant awards from Inasmuch Foundation and Boeing

The Colorado Springs Philharmonic is pleased to announce that it has received a \$40,000 grant from the Oklahoma-based Inasmuch Foundation ([inasmuchfoundation.org](http://inasmuchfoundation.org)) in support of the March 29, 2012 Itzhak Perlman performance. In addition, The Boeing Company has renewed its \$30,000 sponsorship of the Philharmonic's Vanguard Performances series.
